

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

- Diploma or graduation certificate (Turkish translation approved by notary or Turkish Foreign Representatives),
- Undergraduate/graduate transcript or diploma supplement (Turkish translation approved by notary or Turkish Foreign Representatives),
- Copy of the identity-related parts of the passport,
- "Diploma Equivalency Certificate" issued by Turkish Higher Education Council (YÖK) for those who have completed their undergraduate/graduate education abroad in clinical branches, or "University Recognition Certificate by Turkish Higher Education Council (YÖK)" in non-clinical branches,
- Letter of Intent (including the student's postgraduate education purpose, studies and projects),
- CV,
- A valid foreign language exam result (for doctorate candidates),
- At least 55 points from YDS or YÖKDİL exams other than the mother language of the candidates for application to doctorate programs, or, they must get a score equivalent to this score in an exam regarded as valid by YÖK/ÜAK. The Senate decides to increase this minimum score, if necessary, according to the characteristics of the programs,
- Turkish Proficiency Certificate (if any).
